

SUMMARY OF READINGS - ELEVENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

The readings tell us God is faithful in every trial, calling us to trust Christ, who saves, sustains, and leads us through every storm.

In Genesis 37:1-4, 12-28 - Joseph is betrayed and sold by his brothers, but God is working through his suffering to accomplish His greater purpose.

In Psalm 105:1-6, 16-22 - The psalm celebrates God's faithfulness, remembering how He used Joseph's trials to bring deliverance.

In Romans 10:5-15 - Salvation comes through faith in Christ, and believers are called to proclaim the Good News to all.

In Matthew 14:22-33 - Jesus walks on the water, teaching that faith keeps us afloat while fear causes us to sink.
